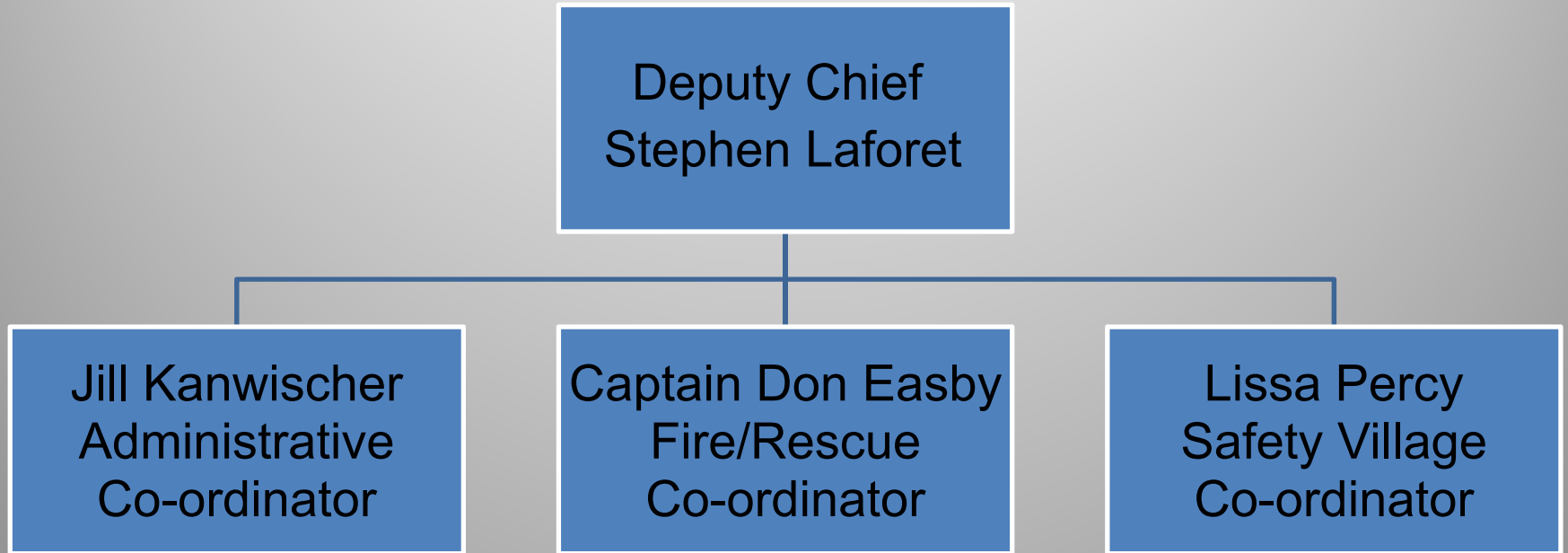

Criteria Used in Selection

- Attendance Record
- Resume
- Cover Letter

Preparing Students

- Dress appropriately for the interview
- Remove any piercings
- Greet the Interviewers and introduce themselves when entering the room
- Listen carefully and do not interrupt
- Make eye contact with interviewers
